**FORMAT** Numeric - 11 characters.

**SOURCE** EWRAS via entry from the MTF or designated clinic/site.

**ELEMENT DEFINITION** This field uniquely identifies the NAS issuance.

**ELEMENT PURPOSE** To locate a specific NAS and to determine the type of issuance. Series 000-699 are valid for thirty days. 700-799 and 900-999 indicate coverage retroactively. 700-799 and 800-899 series are valid for one year. 900-999 are valid for the term of the pregnancy and the mother for up to 42 days after delivery for the mother's inpatient care.

**VALUE SPECIFICATIONS** The first four digits are the DMIS facility identifier. The next four digits are the last digit of the calendar year plus the Julian Day (e.g. Jan 1, 2003 would be 3001).

**NOTE:** Since the EWRAS will not carry any NAS data older than seven years, the last digit of the year will reflect the most recent year for that digit, e.g., 1001 means January 1, 2001, not 1991. The final three digits are the facility sequence number i.e., 000-699 may be assigned in accordance with the implementing instruction of the host Service; 700-799 are assigned to chronic care retroactive INAS issuances; 800-899 are assigned to INASs issued for chronic care, and 900-999 are assigned to INASs and ONASs issued retroactively.

<b>ELEMENT DEFINITION</b>	This field identifies a retroactively issued NAS primarily for maternity cases (900-999) but can also apply to chronic care cases (700-799).		
<b>ELEMENT PURPOSE</b>	To notify the claims processor that NAS coverage occurs retroactively.		
<b>VALUE SPECIFICATIONS</b>	For inpatient care, the date will be the hospital admission date. For maternity cases, the date will be the first prenatal care visit. For outpatient care, the date will be the effective date of care.

<b>ELEMENT DEFINITION</b>	The Major Diagnostic Category Code is the major diagnosis group for the official DRG codes.		
<b>ELEMENT PURPOSE</b>	To distinguish inpatient NAS issuances from outpatient NAS issuances. Codes 01-60 are for inpatient and 61-74 are for outpatient. Also, to determine the type of care for which the NAS was issued. The type of care on the claim is compared to the type of care on the NAS for general agreement.
