## CONTINUOUS POSITIVE AIRWAY PRESSURE (CPAP)

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I. PROCEDURE CODES

HCPCS Level II Codes E0601, E0452, K0183-K0189, K0193-K0194, K0268-K0269

II. DESCRIPTION

CPAP is a non-invasive technique for introducing positive airway pressure into the oropharynx is delivered from a flow-generator through a nose mask, to supply a pressure level sufficient to keep the upper airway patent.

III. POLICY

Nasal continuous positive airway pressure is considered generally accepted medical practice when used in patients with obstructive sleep apnea.
