

## Routine Physical Examinations

### 1.0 CPT<sup>1</sup> PROCEDURE CODES

96110, 99382 - 99387, 99392 - 99397

### 2.0 DESCRIPTION

A routine physical examination is an evaluation and management of the general health of adults and children conducted in the absence of a presenting complaint or other indication of illness or injury.

### 3.0 POLICY

**3.1** A physical examination which leads directly to the diagnosis of a diseased condition is not a routine physical examination and is covered.

**3.2** A physical examination associated with well-child care or associated with a covered clinical preventive care is covered.

**3.3** A physical examination provided when required in the case of a family member who is traveling outside the United States as a result of the member's assignment and such travel is being performed under orders issued by a Uniformed Service is covered.

### 4.0 EXCLUSIONS

**4.1** A routine physical examination.

**4.2** A physical examination required for an application to the United States Department of State for an immigrant visa.

**4.3** An ancillary procedure in support of a routine physical examination.
